Safeguarding policy for Emerald Lakers Basketball Club, aligned with the Consumer Affairs Victoria (CAV) 2025 Model Rules and Basketball Victoria's Child Safe Standards and Member Protection Policies:

Emerald Lakers Basketball Club – Safeguarding Policy (2025)

1. Purpose

Emerald Lakers Basketball Club is committed to providing a safe, inclusive, and respectful environment for all participants—especially children and young people. This policy outlines our safeguarding responsibilities in line with the **CAV 2025 Model Rules**, **Basketball Victoria's Child Safe Standards**, and relevant Victorian legislation.

2. Scope

This policy applies to all club members, volunteers, coaches, officials, committee members, and visitors involved in club activities, programs, and events.

3. Commitment to Child Safety

We are a child-safe organisation. We:

- Prioritise the safety and well-being of children and young people
- Empower children to speak up and participate in decisions that affect them
- Have zero tolerance for child abuse, bullying, or discrimination
- Require all adults working with children to hold valid Working With Children Checks (WWCC)

4. Code of Conduct

All members must follow our **Child Safe Code of Conduct**, which promotes respectful behaviour, appropriate boundaries, and safe interactions. Breaches may result in disciplinary action under our Model Rules.

5. Recruitment and Screening

We follow Basketball Victoria's guidelines for:

- Screening volunteers and staff
- Conducting reference checks
- Ensuring WWCC compliance
- Providing induction and safeguarding training

6. Reporting and Responding

We encourage all concerns to be reported promptly and respectfully.

- Reports can be made to the Club's Child Safety Officer or President
- We will respond to all allegations seriously, confidentially, and in accordance with legal obligations
- Mandatory reporting laws apply to suspected abuse or harm

7. Online Safety and Privacy

We protect children's privacy and safety in digital spaces by:

- Limiting the use of names and images in public communications
- Obtaining parental consent for media use
- · Monitoring social media and messaging platforms used by the club

8. Inclusion and Equity

We celebrate diversity and actively support the participation of:

- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children
- Children from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds
- Children with disabilities
- LGBTQIA+ youth and families

9. Review and Accountability

This policy is reviewed annually or following significant changes in legislation or club operations.
